



INSTITUTIONAL OPERATIONAL STRATEGY FOR THE PROTECTION OF POPULATIONS IN A SITUATION OF VULNERABILITY – ESPOV.

THE NATIONAL POLICE HAS SINCE 2012 DEVELOPED ACTIONS IN THE POLICE SERVICE FOR THE PROTECTION OF VULNERABLE POPULATIONS WITH EMPHASIS ON THE PROTECTION OF GROUPS, INCLUDING DEBTORS, LABORERS, LABOR UNIONS, HUMAN RIGHTS DEFENDERS, INDIGENS, AFRODESCENDANTS, AND LGBTI SOCIAL SECTOR, WOMEN, IDP, DISPLACED JOURNALISTS, AND OTHERS. THIS INSTITUTIONAL OPERATIONAL STRATEGY FOR THE PROTECTION OF POPULATIONS IN A SITUATION OF VULNERABILITY – ESPOV.

CURRENTLY WE CONSIDER AS THE MAIN FACTORS OF ATTENTION THE PHENOMENON OF AFFECTING THE LIFE OF SOCIAL GROUPS AND HUMAN RIGHTS DEFENDERS, AS WELL AS THREATS TO THE INTEGRITY AND PERSONAL SECURITY OF THE COMMUNITIES AND ORGANIZATIONS THAT IN THE TERRITORIES ADVANCE ACTIONS TOWARDS A CULTURE OF PEACE AND COEXISTENCE AND SECURITY, THE STRATEGY IS OPERATIONALIZED THROUGH THREE COMPONENTS:

1. PREVENTION
2. CRIMINAL INVESTIGATION
3. QUICK RESPONSE TO EARLY WARNINGS

AS WELL AS THE DEVELOPMENT OF ACTIONS IN THE SCOPE OF THE "ROUTE OF INSTITUTIONAL AND INTER-INSTITUTIONAL ACTION FOR THE PREVENTION AND PROTECTION OF IDP AND COMMUNITIES IN VULNERABLE SITUATIONS" IN A WORK ARTICULATED WITH COMPETENT LOCAL AUTHORITIES AND INSTITUTIONS.
